

Dolphins at Torry Battery

The Torry Battery is an artillery battery on the coastline of Aberdeen, close to the golden sands of Aberdeen Beach. This historical landmark has overlooked the city since 1859, and was once used to protect Aberdeen's harbour against raiders whilst also being used in both the First and Second World Wars.

Today, Torry Battery is home to the <u>Greyhope Bay Centre</u> - the perfect spot for dolphin watching whilst enjoying hot drinks and a bite to eat. This visitor attraction is an "offgrid" eco-facility built by converting shipping containers, and is one of the best places on Scotland's coastline to spot bottlenose dolphins.

This is just one of the many unforgettable experiences you can have whilst visiting the Granite City.
