21 + 22 CARRIE REICHARDT (UK)

Carrie Reichardt is a self-titled 'craftivist'. Her work blurs the boundaries between craft and activism, using the techniques of muralism, mosaic and screen-printing to create intricate, highly-politicised works of art.

Earlier this year, Carrie visited Aberdeen to research the Aberdeen City Council archives and took a particular interest in themes relating to witchcraft and the suffragettes with an aim to bring the stories to life through mosaic artworks across the city centre. Carrie's flagship piece is situated on St Nicholas Street and if you look closely you will see some familiar trailblazing Aberdonian women along with some you may want to research for yourself.

Carrie worked in partnership with Amnesty International in support of women human rights defenders in the UK and completed a piece called 'Suffragette Spirit' which is an informative and thought provoking artwork created using classic revolutionary imagery and the suffragette signature colours of purple, green and white. You will be able to find 'Suffragette Spirit' in the Adelphi, just off of Union Street (22).
