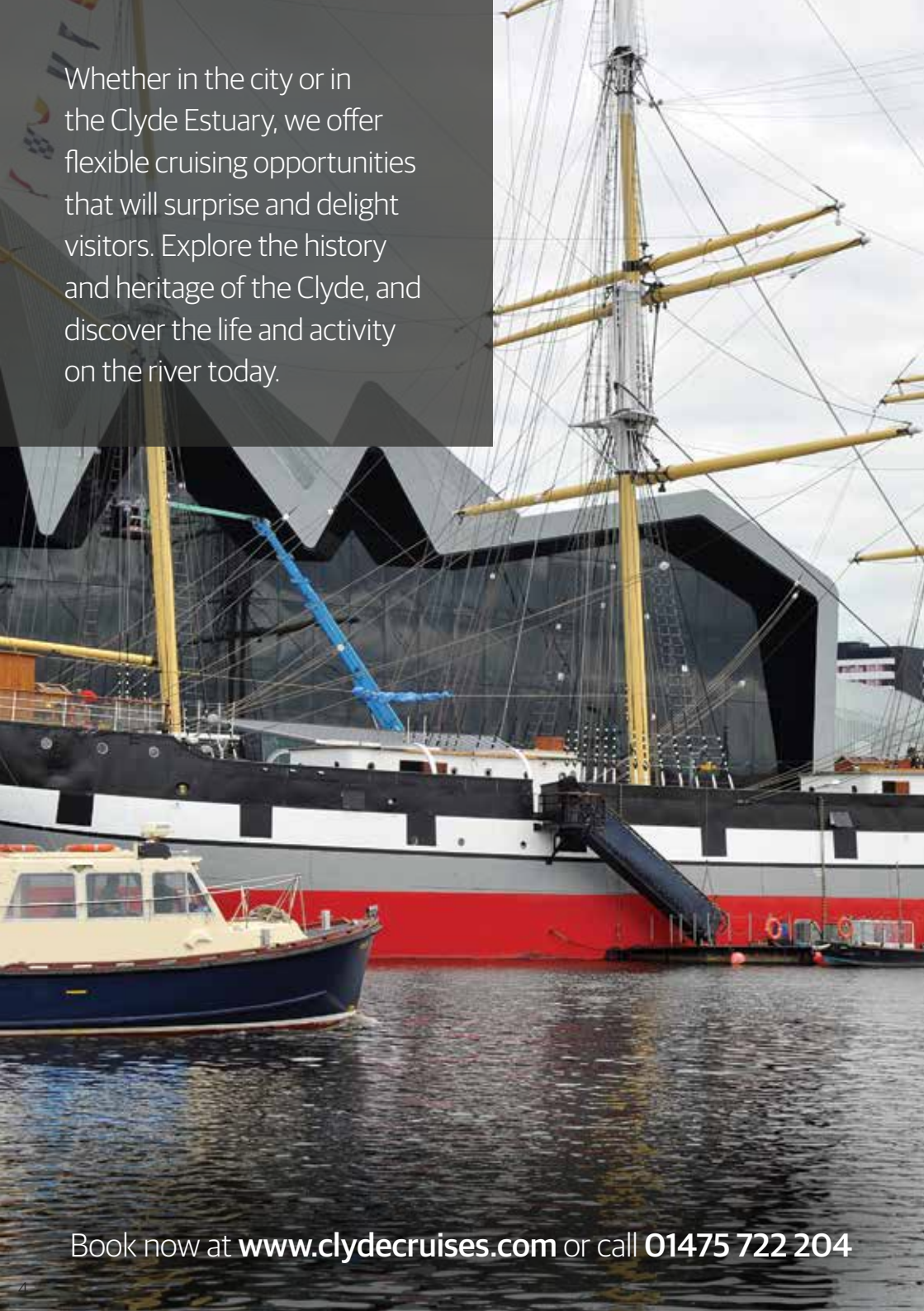

Cycle the Great Glen Way

Exploring the Caledonian Canal by bike is the best way to experience the Great Glen and an ideal way to get your family active and outdoors. Our combination ticket will make the most of your time in this area, famous for its landscape, scenery and wildlife. We have partnered with two professional bike hire companies who will kit you out with the correct bikes and helmets. With kids bikes, tag-alongs and trailers we will make sure you are fully equipped for your adventure. Our team will also provide you with maps and information about the cycling area.

½ Day Experience

This ticket includes a 1 hr, one way canal cruise followed by 2 hrs bike hire. Possible routes include a sailing from Banavie to Gairloch, cycling back to Banavie. This would take approximately 3 hours in total. Alternatively you could sail from Laggan to Gairloch, cycling back to Laggan which would also take 3 hours in total.

Please arrive at least 30 minutes before your cruise departs – make your way to the **Rockhopper** hub at Banavie or the **Scottish Canals** Visitor Centre at Laggan to pick up your bikes before boarding the boat. For morning half day hires, all bikes should be returned by 1300 and afternoon bike hires returned by 1630. For full day hires, bikes should be returned by 1630.

Enjoying stunning views of majestic castles including Dunstaffnage Castle, Duart Castle, Gylen Castle and Dunollie Castle.

Corryvreckan Whirlpool

5 hrs 30 mins

Head out of Dunstaffnage Marina at Oban to the world famous Corryvreckan Whirlpool (the 3rd largest whirlpool in the world) with views of Gylen Castle, the Atlantic Bridge, Easdale and the slate islands.

The Gulf of Corryvreckan (from the Gaelic Coire Bhreacain meaning 'cauldron of the speckled seas') is a narrow strait between the islands of Jura and Scarba.

Enjoy the amazing scenery and chance of spotting sea eagles, porpoises, minke whales and more. Strong Atlantic currents and unusual underwater topography create the particularly intense tidal race in the Corryvreckan channel, creating whirlpools, standing waves and a variety of other surface effects.

The return sailing takes in the beautiful and remote Garvellach islands.

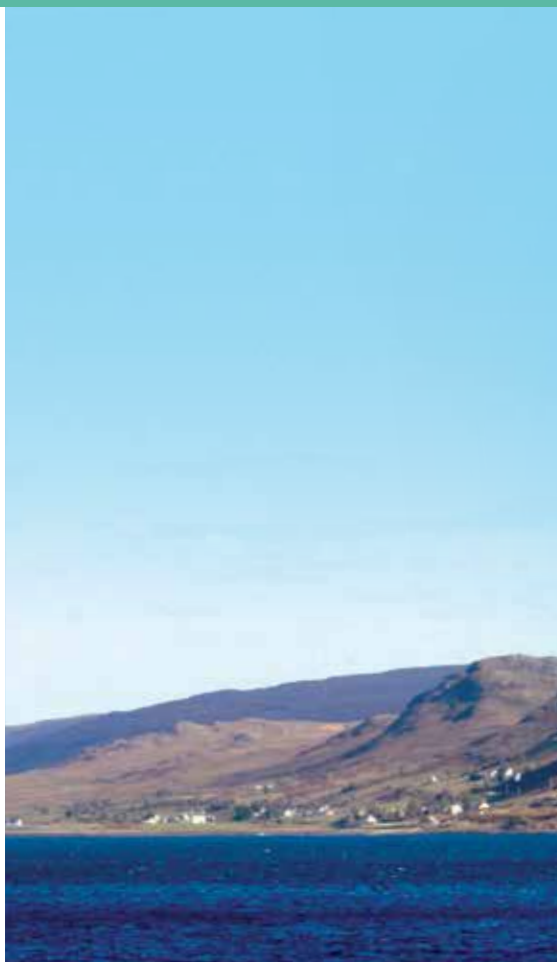
